WHAT IS A SCHOOL

DAY?

A school day is the period from the midnight before to 30 minutes after the end of the official school day

## WHAT IS A COMPETITIVE FOOD AND/OR BEVERAGE?

Any item(s) <u>sold</u> on the school campus, during the school day that is not part of the reimbursable school meal.

#### **FUNDRAISERS**

All foods that meet the regulatory standards: May be sold as fundraisers On the school campus During school day <u>Standards do not apply to:</u> Items sold during non-school hours Items not for consumption at the school Off-campus fundraising events Items sold to "non" students

#### **Record Keeping**

#### All schools are responsible for keeping the following records:

- Purchase receipts
- Nutrition labels
- Information about sales (time, place, date, etc.)
- Product specifications
- Report from smart snacks calculator showing compliance
